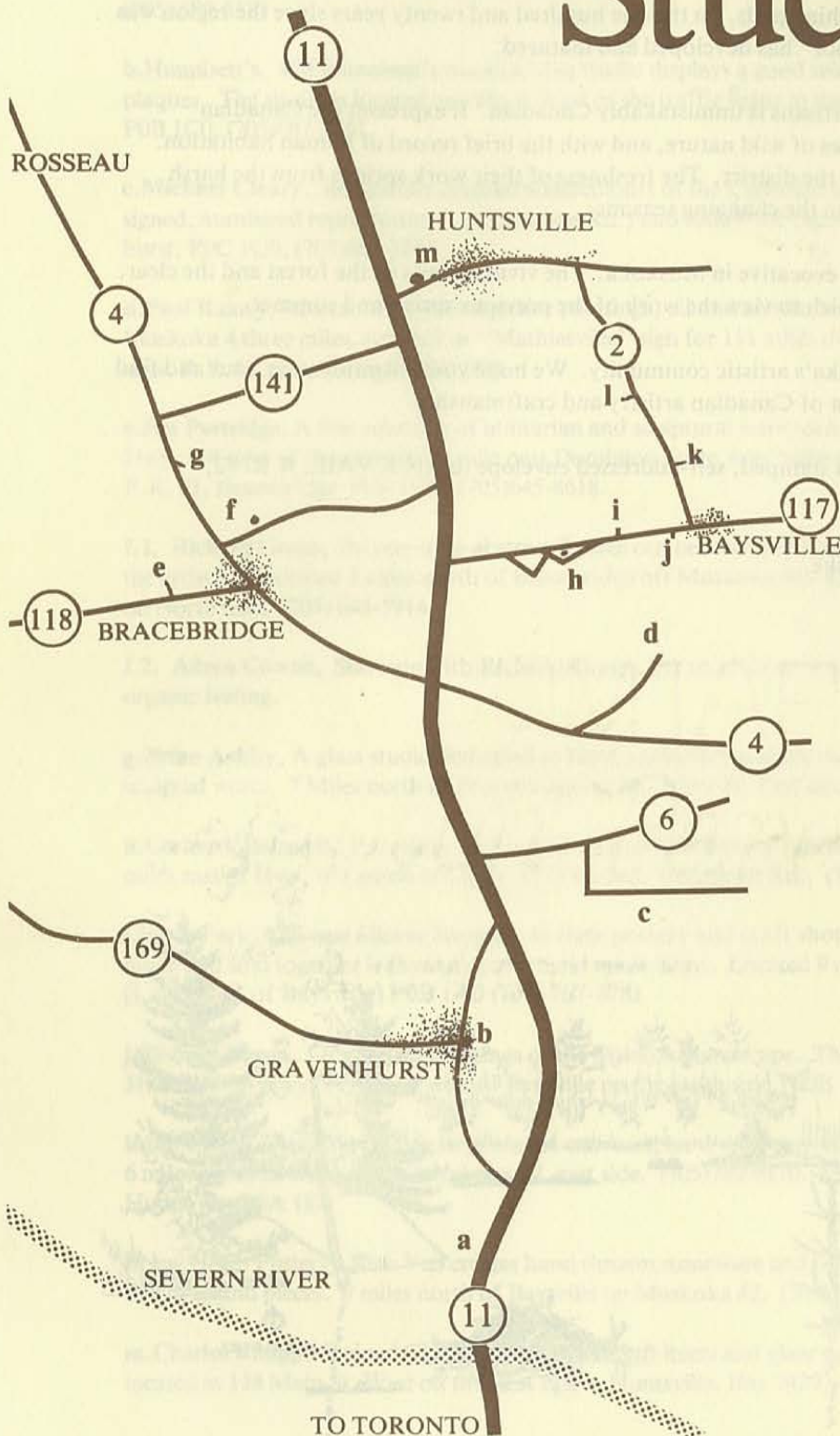

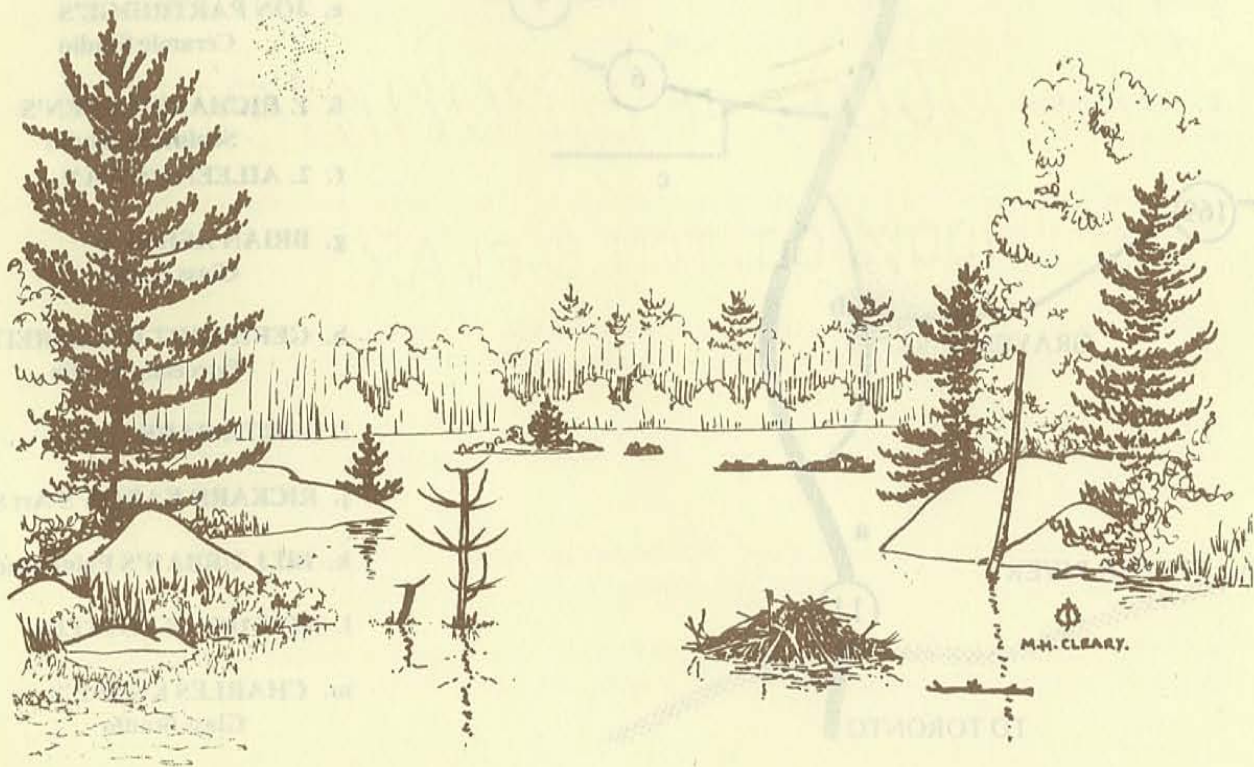

## MUSKOKA STUDIO AUTUMN TOUR

**A.** The Artisan's Gallery. In **Wayne Church's** Studio you will see the functional and sculptural objects he forges and his oil and acrylic paintings. The Gallery is 1 mile north of the Severn River, on the west side of Hwy. 11. (705) 689-6121

**b.** Hunnisett's. **Bill Hunnisett's** woodcarving studio displays a good selection of his hand carved figures and wall plaques. The studio is located one block West of the traffic lights in the centre of Gravenhurst at 181 Bay St., POB 1C0, (705)687-3751.

**c.** **Michael Cleary.** Beautifully detailed watercolours of the Canadian landscape, both original paintings and signed, numbered reproductions. (Doe Lake Rd.) and follow the signs - only two miles. Box 1368, Gravenhurst, POC 1G0, (705)687-5264.

**d.** **Paul Rainey,** Abstract and non objective paintings, oil and acrylic, some sculpture. From Hwy. 11, east on Muskoka 4 three miles, turn left at "Mathiasville" sign for 1½ miles over iron bridge ¼ mile and look for sign. R.R.#3, Bracebridge POB 1C0

**e.** **Jon Partridge,** A fine selection of utilitarian and sculptural ware set in a quaint near century farm setting. Hwy. 118 west of Bracebridge, 1 mile past Dominion Store, turn right at sign. Up 1½ miles then turn left. R.R. #1, Bracebridge POB 1C0, (705)645-8618.

**f.1.** **Richard Green,** Bronze semi-abstract figures can be seen at this sculptor's studio, designed and built by the artist, and located 3 miles north of Bracebridge off Muskoka Rd. 4, East on High Falls Rd., ¼ mile on North side, (705) 645-5914.

**f.2.** **Aileen Cowan,** Showing with Richard Green. her small bronze abstract sculptures have a graceful and organic feeling.

**g.** **Brian Ashby,** A glass studio dedicated to hand-made blown glass, traditionally formed, functional and sculpted wares. 7 Miles north of Bracebridge on Muskoka #4, East side.

**h.** **Gerhardt Balzerit,** Porcelain studio with a good selection of functional and sculptural porcelain. Located 3½ miles east of Hwy. #11 south off Hwy. #117 on 2nd. Stoneleigh Rd., (705) 645-9691.

**i.** Earth Park. **Ken and Gloria Hoeght.** At their pottery and craft shop, functional stone ware and porcelain is made and sold together with many other hand made items. Located 9 miles east of Hwy. #11 on Hwy. #117 (1 mile west of Baysville) POB 1A0 (705) 767-3781

**j.** **Richard Karon,** Original oil paintings of the Muskoka landscape. The Studio is located 10 miles east of Hwy. #11 on Hwy. #117, just west of Baysville on the south side. POB 1A0, (705) 767-3275.

**k.** **Bill Urban,** Painting studio, large acrylic canvases, hard-edge surrealism and abstract expressionism. Located 6 miles north of Baysville on Muskoka #2, east side. (705)789-9110. Mailing address, General Delivery, Huntsville POA 1K0.

**l.** New Holm Pottery. **Rick Vail** creates hand thrown stoneware and porcelain including some handbuilt and one of a kind pieces. 9 miles north of Baysville on Muskoka #2, (705) 789-9356.

**m.** **Charles Knapp.** Stained Glass, lamps, panels, gift items and glass supplies are a specialty. His studio is located at 138 Main St. West on the west side in Huntsville, Box 2429, (705)789-8291.
