



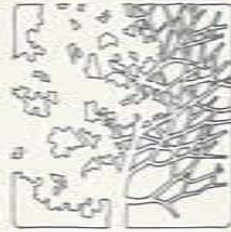

**A. The Artisan's Gallery, Wayne Church's metal studio,** offers distinctive one-of-a-kind sculptures and unique forged furnishings and accessories. Located on the west side of Hwy 11; northbound turn back 3 km. from Sparrow Lake Route D overpass, southbound, 15 km. from Gravenhurst. Box 88, Severn Bridge, POE 1N0. (705)689-6121.
