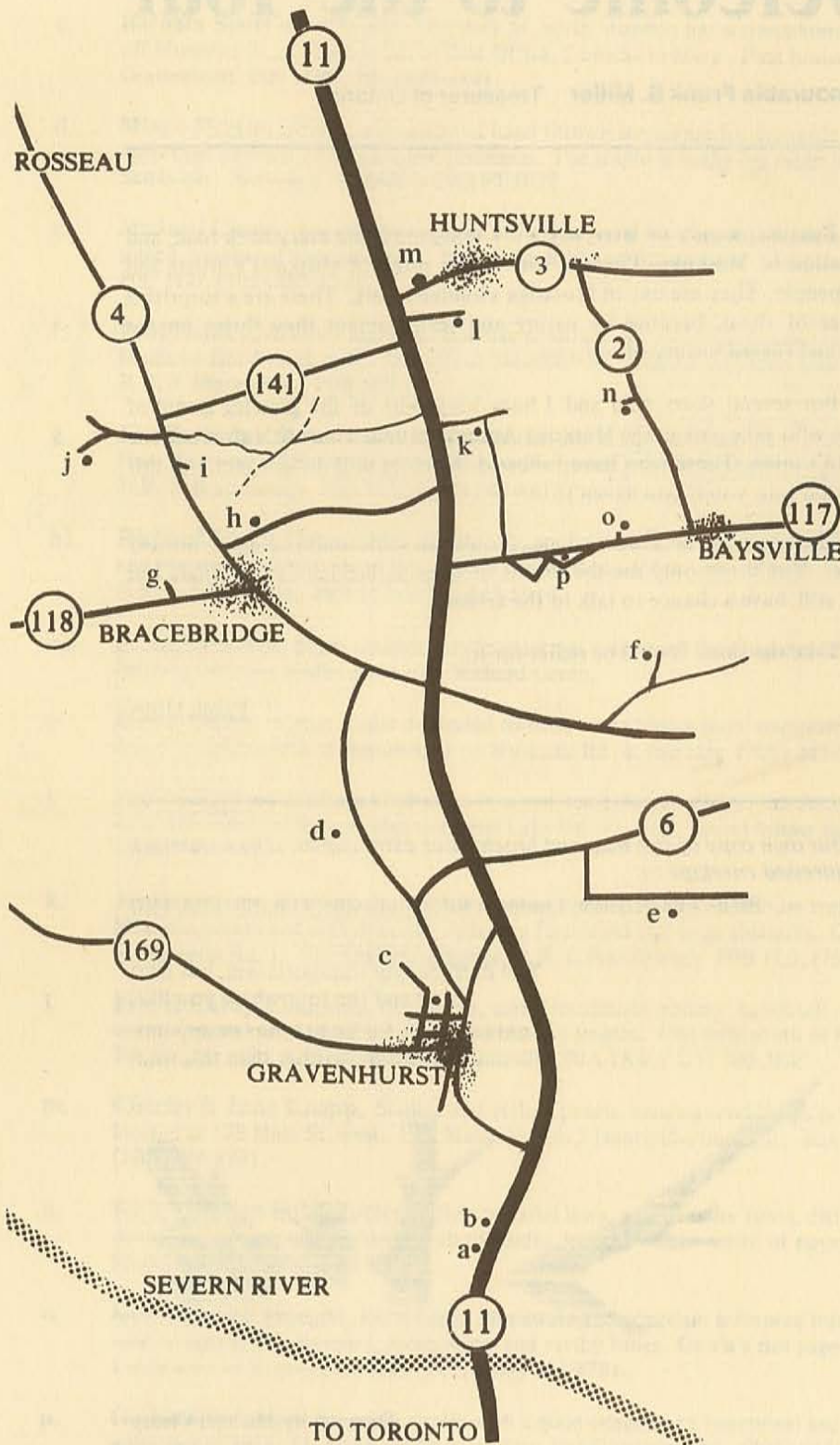

# Muskoka Autumn Studio Tour 1982

- a. **The Artisan's Gallery.** In **Wayne Church's** studio, you will see the functional and sculptural metal pieces he forges, and his acrylic paintings. The Gallery is 1 mile north of the Severn River, on the west side of Hwy. 11, Box 88, Severn Bridge POE 1N0, (705) 689-6121.
- b. **Muskoka Palm Studio. David & Karen Woolcox.** Traditional and contemporary designs in stained glass. Studio is located 3 miles south of Gravenhurst, on the west side of Highway 11, R.R. 1, Gravenhurst POC 1G0, (705) 687-6942.
- c. **Barbara Scott's Art Studio,** 340 Mary St. north, displays her watercolours and charcoal drawings. Turn west off Muskoka St., 1 block north of Post Office, 2 blocks to Mary. First house north, east side, Box 1095, Gravenhurst POC 1G0, (705) 687-2791.
- d. **Mieke Martin,** Offers a wide range of hand thrown stoneware for domestic use, oven to tableware. Also individual pieces in stoneware and porcelain. The studio is in the log cabin just inside the main gate of Muskoka Sands inn. Note sign: MIEKE'S CRAFT HUT.
- e. **Michael Cleary,** Beautifully detailed watercolours of the Canadian landscape, both original paintings and signed, numbered reproductions. (Doe Lake Rd.) and follow signs – only two miles. Box 1368, Gravenhurst, POC 1G0, (705) 687-5264.
- f. **Paul Rainey,** Abstract and non objective paintings, oil and acrylic, some sculpture. From Hwy. 11, east on Muskoka Rd. 4 three miles, turn left at "Mathiasville" sign for 1½ miles over iron bridge ¼ mile and look for sign. R.R. 3, Bracebridge POB 1C0.
- g. **Jon Partridge,** A fine selection of utilitarian and sculptural ware set in a quaint near century farm setting. Hwy. 118 west of Bracebridge, 1 mile past Dominion store, turn right at sign. Up 1½ miles then turn left. R.R. 1, Bracebridge POB 1C0, (705) 645-8618.
- h1. **Richard Green,** Bronze semi-abstract figures can be seen at this sculptor's studio, designed and built by the artist, and located 3 miles north of Bracebridge off Muskoka Rd. 4, east on High Falls Rd., ¼ mile on north side, R.R. 2, Bracebridge POB 1C0, (705) 645-5914.
- h2. **Doug Dunford;** Super realistic acrylic paintings and pencil drawings depicting the strength and integrity of rural Ontario. Sharing studio space with Richard Green.
- i. **Brian Ashby,** A glass studio dedicated to hand-made blown glass, traditionally formed, functional and sculpted wares. 7 miles north of Bracebridge on Muskoka Rd. 4, east side, (705) 385-2989.
- j. **John O'Byrne,** Designer/Craftsman in wood; handcrafted pieces both functional and whimsical. Muskoka Rd. 4, 9 miles north of Bracebridge to Camel Lake Rd., turn left (west) follow signs to last farm on left, (2 miles), (705) 385-2196.
- k. **Janice Barnes,** Paintings throughout a converted red-brick schoolhouse including some figurative naive-style Muskoka scenes and earlier works, including figuratives and large abstracts. One mile east of Hwy. 11, on Stephenson Rd. 1. The Old Schoolhouse, R.R. 1, Port Sydney POB 1L0, (705) 385-3020.
- l. **Eric & Cathy Lindgren,** Distinctive, useful handmade pottery, handbuilt and wheel thrown forms in stoneware. Original painted silks, scarves and kimono lengths. One mile south of Huntsville. Turn east on Lindgren Rd. for one mile. General Delivery, Huntsville POA 1K0, (705) 789-2843.
- m. **Charles & June Knapp,** Stained and etched panels, hangings and lamps in our new showroom. The studio is located at 138 Main St. west. Exit Muskoka Rd. 3 Huntsville, one mile. Box 2429, Huntsville POA 1K0, (705) 789-8291.
- n. **Rick Vail-Newholm Pottery,** Subtle pastel hues, warm earthy tones, distinguish the delicate porcelain and stoneware to be found at this woodland studio, located 9 miles north of Baysville, 6 miles south of Huntsville on Muskoka Rd. 2, (705) 789-9356.
- o. **Ken & Gloria Hoeght,** Earth Park. Stoneware and porcelain is formed into unique, functional pieces using various Japanese techniques, giving warm and earthy tones. Gloria's rice paper lamp shades accent their lamps. 1 mile west of Baysville on Hwy. 117, (705) 767-3781.
- p. **Gerhard Balzereit,** Porcelain studio with a good selection of functional and sculptural porcelain. Located 3½ miles east of Hwy. 11, south off Hwy. 117 on 2nd Stoneleigh Rd., (705) 645-9691.
