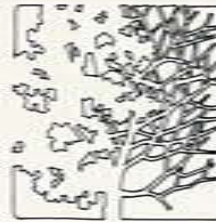

Brenda Wainman Goulet.** At her sculpture studio/gallery on Walker Lake, Brenda creates unique bronze or stone sculptures which depict a variety of Muskoka landscapes reminiscent of Group of Seven canvases. 11 km. east of Huntsville along Hwy 60, at Lamberlost Rd. (Muskoka Rd. 8), turn north (left); 2 km. to Upper Walker Lake Rd., turn left, then right at stop sign. RR 4 Box 234, Huntsville, P0A 1K0. (705) 635-1996. Hours: Special shows or by appointment.

**B. Jeff Miller,** painter, Lamberlost Studio. Warning! Colour and vitality thrive here, even the dearest of souls may become excited. Algonquin paintings celebrate the park's 100th birthday. 11 km. east of Huntsville go north on Lamberlost Rd. (Muskoka Rd. 8) go left, 150 metres. First turn left after firehall. **C. Charles Knapp** Stained Glass. See why Charles has published his third book of Lamp Designs. Gorgeous gifts. Custom work a specialty. From Hwy. 11, exit Muskoka Rd. 3 East 1. 3 km. Lindgren Pottery:** Eric Lindgren presents handmade stoneware pottery: special pieces and a line of functional pots, including dinnerware, for the kitchen, oven, and table; all designed for beauty and function. **E. Ken Hoeght,** Earth Park Pottery. Porcelain and stoneware is formed into unique, functional pieces using various Japanese techniques, giving warm and earthy tones. **F. Bill Hunnisett** creates unique, finely detailed woodcarvings from a variety of woods, including Muskoka driftwood. Located 5.5 km. west of Bent River just off Hwy 141. Travelling west on Hwy. 141, turn left (south) at the first road past Camp Hollyburn. Proceed 1/8 km. to end of road. Travelling east on 141, 6 km. from the town of Rosseau. RR 1, Uterson, P0B 1M0. **G. Rach Canoes, Will Ruch** builds traditional cedar canvas canoes with a craftsman's attention to quality and finish. Muskoka Rd. #7 to Minett, first left north of the Corner Store onto River Rd., follow for 2 km. Minett Post Office, Muskoka, P0B 1G0 (705) 765-5390. Hours: By appointment.

**H. Doug Gatche.** Carved burl bowls and marquetry are featured at the Artistry in Wood Studio on Butterfly Lake in Glen Orchard.
