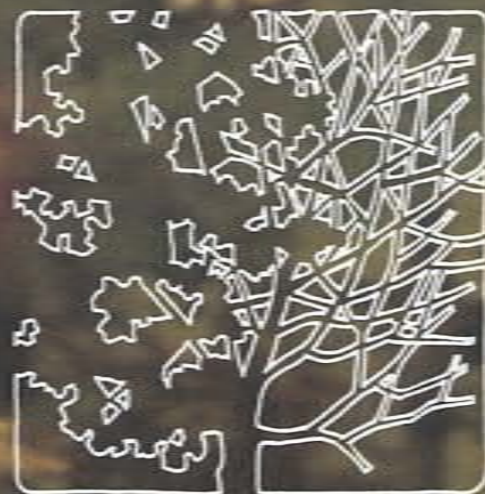

and see their work in the context of their studios.

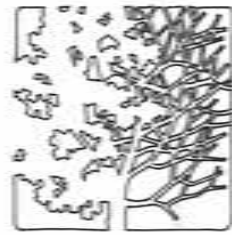
You must supply transportation, but start and end this FREE tour where you like.

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A. Brenda Wainman Goulet. Enjoy Brenda's distinctive bronze-on-stone landscapes, whimsical figures and other surprises at her studio/gallery on Walker Lake. Watch her demonstrate the ancient "lost wax" process by which she creates her unique bronze sculptures. 12 km. east of Huntsville along Hwy 60, at Limberlost Rd. (Muskoka Rd #8), turn left (north), go 3 km. to Upper Walker Lake Rd., turn left, then right at the stop sign. RR 4 Box 234, Huntsville, P1H 2J6. (705) 635-1996. Hours: Special shows, by chance or appointment.

B. Elizabeth Johnson, Painter. The Shoe Box Studio. Watercolours, oils, acrylics, pastels and mixed media. Depictions of the rugged highlands of Eastern Muskoka. Scenes of domestic and small town life and folk. Studio on Shoe Lake Rd, off Hwy 35, approx. 4 km. south of Dorset. Box 103, Dorset, P0A 1E0. (705) 766-9783. Hours: Usually open Sat. 10-5 in summer. C. Charles Knapp Stained Glass. Gorgeous gifts, lamps and windows. Year round custom work. Take Hwy 60, 4 km. east from Huntsville to Canal Rd. (Deerhurst exit) and turn right. Turn right again at Y intersection. Go over the canal bridge and at the next Y intersection turn right onto Swallowdale Rd. Studio is second house on the right. RR 4, GB #413, Huntsville, P1H 2J6. (705) 789-8291. Hours: We are usually open to receive visitors but you may like to call ahead. Sundays closed.

D. Eric Lindgren. Lindgren Pottery presents handmade stoneware pottery: special pieces in addition to a line of functional pots, including square dinnerware, for the kitchen, table, and garden; all designed for beauty and function. Lindgren Pottery is just south of Huntsville off Hwy 11. Turn east on Lindgren Road for 2 km. 320 Lindgren Rd. East, Huntsville, P1H 1Y6. (705) 789-2843. Hours: 10 am to 4 pm (Summer: Mon. to Sat., Fall: Wed. to Sat.), or by appointment.

E. Janet Stahle-Fraser, Tapawingo Studio. Janet offers an array of original hand-pulled prints that include woodcuts, linocuts, etchings monoprints, stone lithographs and stencil prints. Also, hand-printed/bound collector's books. 1 km. east of Baysville on Hwy 117. Entrance on north side. Box 125, Baysville, P0B 1A0. (705) 767-3594. Hours: Usually open May-Sept. F. Bill Hunnisett creates unique, finely detailed woodcarvings from a variety of woods, including Muskoka driftwood. Located 5.5 km. west of Bent River just off Hwy 141. Travelling west on Hwy. 141, turn left (south) at the first road past Camp Hollyburn. Proceed 1/8 km. to end of road. Travelling east on 141, 6 km. from the town of Rosseau. RR 1, Utterson, P0B 1M0. G. Ed Novak is a realist painter who works in the medium of water-colour. Ed's characteristically rich and colourful still lifes, landscapes and portraits, capture the moods and images of Muskoka.
