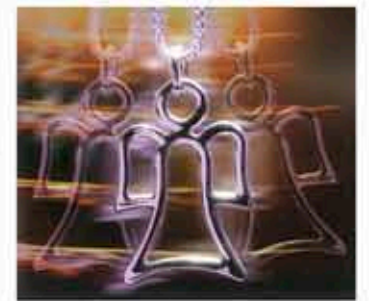

## Muskoka Autumn Studio Tour September 25th - 26th, 2004

Join the 28 artists and craftspeople of Muskoka in their studios and showrooms for the 26th year. Listen to the rhythmic seasaw of sandpaper for a fine wood finish and the hum of the potter's wheel as a lump of clay is squeezed and pulled into a bowl. Be mesmerized by the roar of a furnace full of molten glass that awaits the magical dip of the blow rod and observe the keen concentration of the jeweller as the hammer taps and bends the curve of a shiny silver bracelet. Fly along with the paintbrush as it adds the blue sky on the canvas and with the sizzle of the solder as it flows over the fine design of a stained glass window. Watch as the hammer forges glowing red iron or tools a copper sheet. Touch the cool curves of a sculpture poured from molten bronze. Let your senses come alive. We invite you.

Canada's original Studio Tour organized and funded by the participating studios is an opportunity for you to visit the artists and craftspeople of Muskoka and see their work in the context of their studios. You must supply transportation. Due to parking limitations, bus tours are not advised. Start and end this FREE tour where you like.

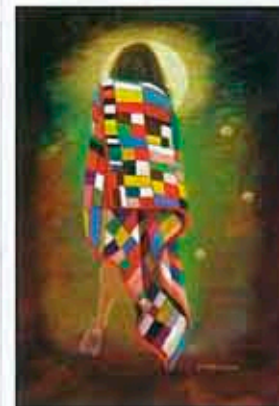

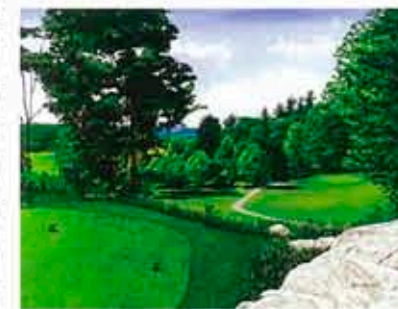

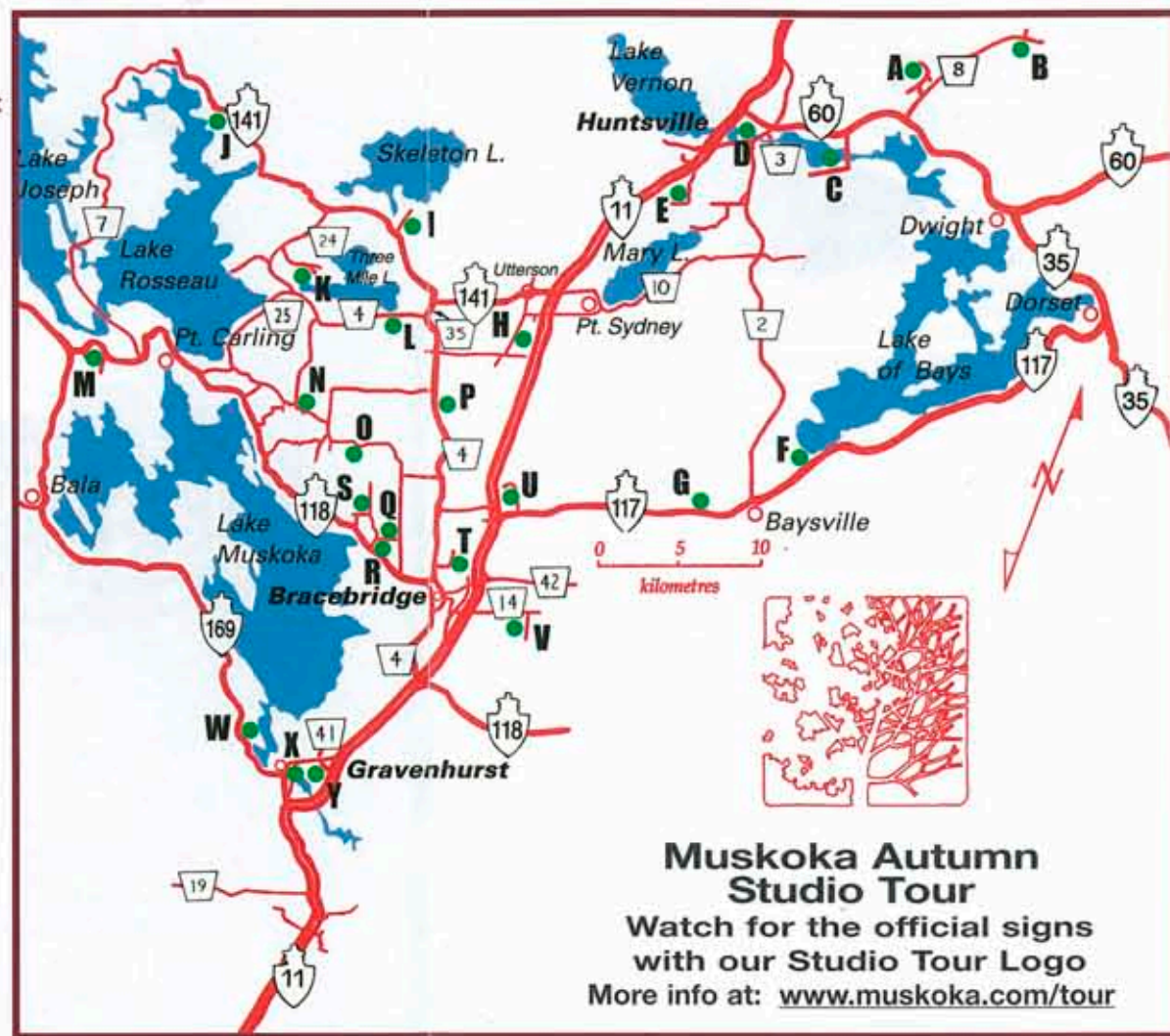
