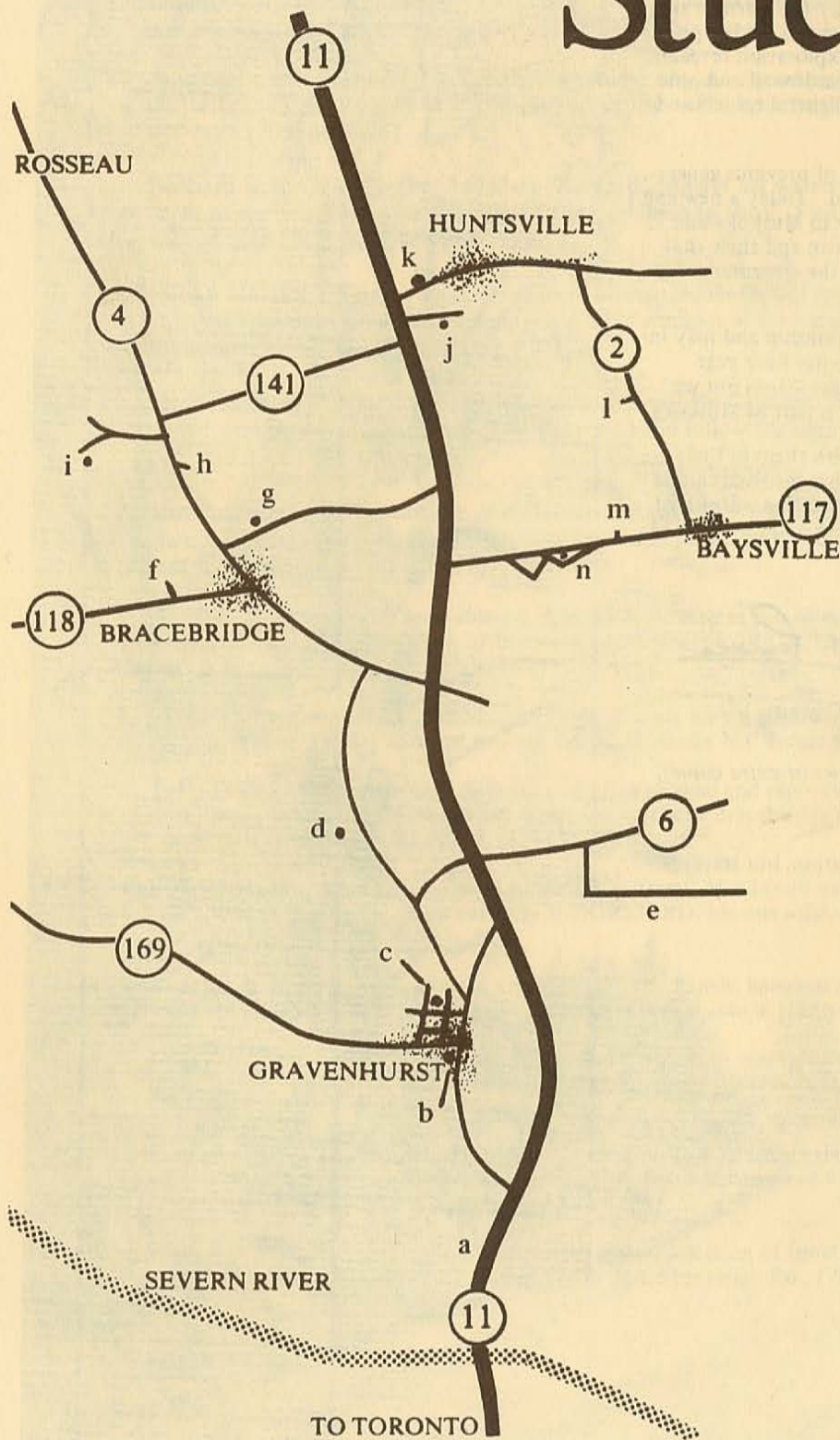


Welcome to Our Studios

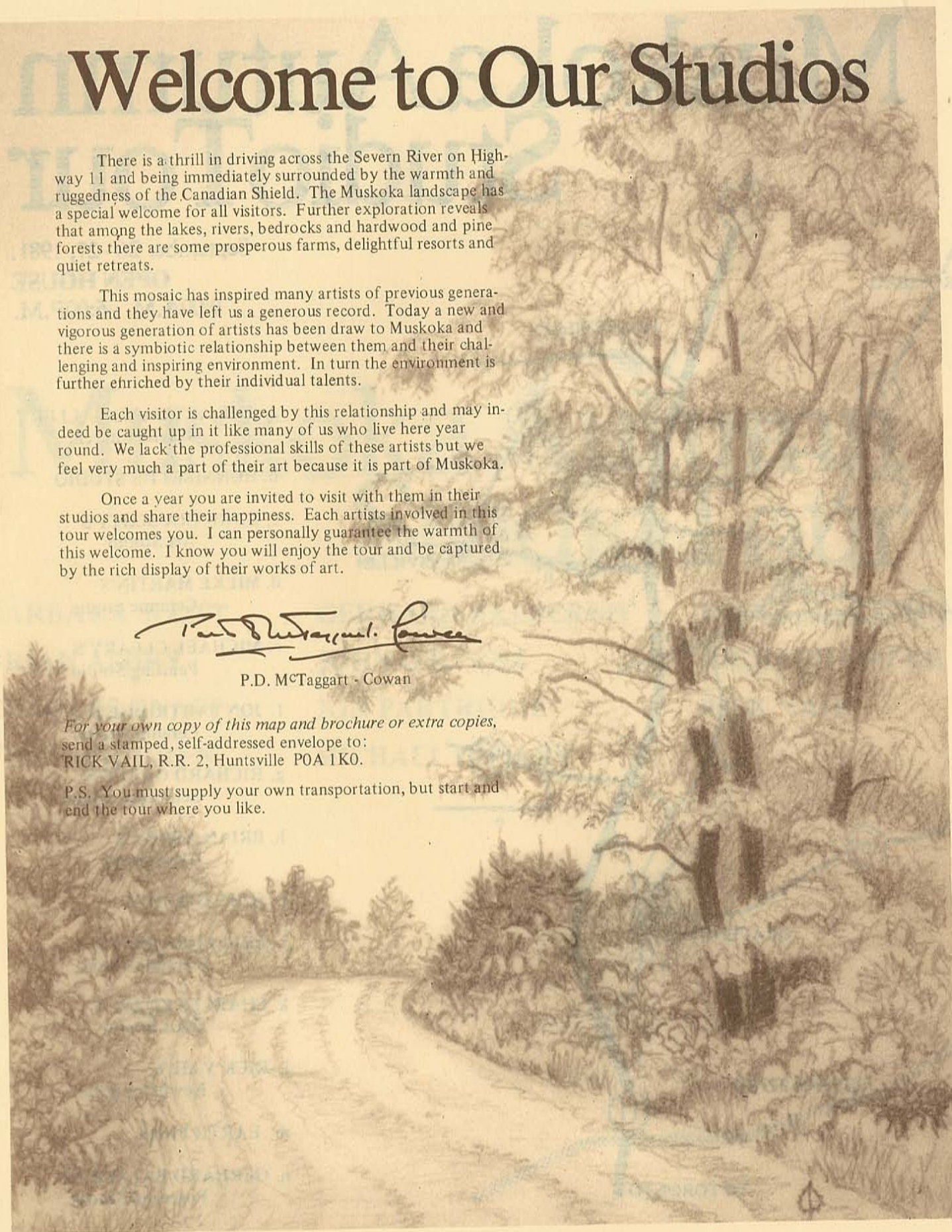

MUSKOKA AUTUMN STUDIO TOUR

- a. The Artisan's Gallery. In **Wayne Church's** Studio you will see the functional and sculptural objects he forges and his oil and acrylic paintings. The Gallery is 1 mile north of the Severn River, on the west side of Hwy. 11, Box 88, Severn Bridge POE 1N0, (705) 689-6121.
- b. Hunnisett's **Bill Hunnisett's** woodcarving studio displays a good selection of his hand carved figures and wall plaques. The studio is located ½ a block West of the traffic lights in the centre of Gravenhurst at 181 Bay St., POC 1G0, (705) 687-3751.
- c. **Barbara Scott's** Art Studio, 340 Mary St., North displays her watercolours and charcoal drawings. Turn west off Muskoka St., 1 block north of Post Office, 2 blocks to Mary. First house north, east side. Box 1095, Gravenhurst POC 1G0, (705) 687-2791.
- d. **Mieke Martin**, Offers a wide range of hand thrown stoneware for domestic use, oven to tableware. Also individual pieces in stoneware and porcelain. The studio is in the log cabin just inside the main gate of Muskoka Sands Inn. Note sign MIEKE'S CRAFT HUT.
- e. **Michael Cleary**, Beautifully detailed watercolours of the Canadian landscape, both original paintings and signed, numbered reproductions. (Doe Lake Rd.) and follow the signs - only two miles. Box 1368, Gravenhurst, POC 1G0, (705) 687-5264.
- f. **Jon Partridge**, A fine selection of utilitarian and sculptural ware set in a quaint near century farm setting. Hwy. 118 west of Bracebridge, 1 mile past Dominion Store, turn right at sign. Up 1½ miles then turn left. R.R. 1, Bracebridge POB 1C0, (705) 645-8618.
- g. **Richard Green**, Bronze semi-abstract figures can be seen at this sculptor's studio, designed and built by the artist, and located 3 miles north of Bracebridge off Muskoka Rd. 4, East on High Falls Rd., ¼ mile on North side, R.R. 2, Bracebridge POB 1C0, (705) 645-5914.
- h. **Brian Ashby**, A glass studio dedicated to hand-made blown glass, traditionally formed, functional and sculpted wares. 7 miles north of Bracebridge on Muskoka No. 4, east side.
- i. **John O'Byrne**, Designer and craftsman offering original and reproduction furniture in hard and soft woods (some sculptural work.) Muskoka Rd. 4, 9 miles north of Bracebridge to Camel Lake Rd. turn left (west) follow signs to last farm on left. (2 miles), (705) 385-2196.
- j. **Eric Lindgren**, Distinctive, useful handmade pottery. Hand-built and wheel-thrown forms in stoneware. One mile south of Huntsville. Turn east on LINDGREN RD. for one mile. (705) 789-2843, Gen Delivery, Huntsville POA 1K0.
- k. **Charles & June Knapp**, Stained and etched glass. Panels, hangings and lamps. Custom orders our pleasure. Their studio is located at 138 Main St., West on the west side in Huntsville, Box 2429, (705) 789-8291.
- l. **Rick Vail-Newholm Pottery**, Subtle pastel hues, warm earthy tones, distinguish the delicate porcelain and stoneware to be found at this woodland studio, located 9 miles north of Baysville, 6 miles south of Huntsville on Muskoka Rd. No. 2, (705) 789-9356.
- m. Earth Park. **Ken and Gloria Hoeght**, At their pottery and craft shop, functional stone ware and porcelain is made and sold together with many other hand made items. Located 9 miles east of Hwy. 11, on Hwy. 117, (1 mile west of Baysville) POB 1A0, (705) 767-3781.
- n. **Gerhardt Balzereit**, Porcelain studio with a good selection of functional and sculpral porcelain. Located 3½ miles east of Hwy. 11, south off Hwy. 117 on 2nd. Stoneleigh Rd., (705) 645-9691.
